## In Law

### ● Objectives of the training program

The law degree is a general legal education that provides solid skills in public and private law, while offering transversal skills in economics, sociology, English and computer science.

### ● Target audience

- 1st year : holders of a 'baccalauréat', 'DAEU' (diploma of access to university studies) + capacity in law.
- 2nd year : L1 'Law' or 'AES' (Economic and social administration) + beneficiaries of a validation of prior learning after a DUT 'Legal careers' or a BTS 'notary' (admission subject to the opinion of a pedagogical commission).
- 3rd year : L2 Law + beneficiaries of a validation of prior experience ('VAE').
- Continuing education: resumption of studies or 'VAE'

### ● Job opportunities

- competitive exams for jobs in the civil service (clerk, labor inspector, tax administration officer, 'attaché territorial' officer in local and regional authorities, police officer, officer in the 'gendarmerie', youth judicial protection educator, integration and probation advisor, etc.)
- competitive exams for jobs in the European Union institutions
- competitive exams for jobs in parliamentary assemblies
- private sector legal professions (notary clerk, bank advisor, insurance advisor, business advisor, real estate agent, etc.)

#### Further studies :

- Master's degree in Law (public law, private law, business law, criminal science, etc.)

- Obtaining a master's degree allows access, by competitive examination, to the legal professions (lawyer, notary, bailiff), as well as to the administrative and judicial courts.
- It also makes it possible to pursue doctoral studies.
